Mr. SIMON submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules and Administration

RESOLUTION

To replace the membership of the Select Committee on Ethics with former Members selected by the Majority Leader and the Minority Leader.

1 *Resolved*, That (a) subsection (a) of the first section
2 of Senate Resolution 338, agreed to July 24, 1964, is
3 amended to read as follows: “(a) there is hereby estab-
4 lished a permanent select committee of the Senate to be
5 known as the Select Committee on Ethics (referred to
6 hereinafter as the ‘Select Committee’) consisting of 6
7 former Members of the Senate, of whom 3 shall be selected
8 by the Majority Leader and 3 shall be selected by the Mi-
9 nority Leader. The Select Committee shall select a chair
10 and a vice chair from among its members. Members of

1 the Select Committee shall be entitled to a per diem
2 of \$400 plus travel expenses while serving on the Select
3 Committee.”.

4 (b) Subsection (e) of the first section of Senate Reso-
5 lution 338, agreed to July 24, 1964, is repealed.

6 (c) The amendments made by this resolution shall
7 take effect on May 1, 1993.
