CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Providing for the adjournment of the two Houses.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That when the House adjourns on the legisla-
3 tive day of Thursday, February 1, 1996, it stand ad-
4 journd until 12:30 p.m. on Monday, February 26, 1996,
5 or until noon on the second day after Members are notified
6 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
7 olution, whichever occurs first; and that when the Senate
8 recesses or adjourns at the close of business on Thursday,
9 February 1, 1996, Tuesday, February 6, 1996, Wednes-
10 day, February, 7, 1996, Thursday, February 8, 1996,
11 Tuesday, February 13, 1996, Wednesday, February 14,
12 1996, or Thursday, February 15, 1996, pursuant to a mo-

1 tion made by the Majority Leader or his designee in ac-
2 cordance with this resolution, it stand recessed or ad-
3 journed until 3 p.m. on Monday, February 26, 1996, or
4 until noon on the second day after Members are notified
5 to reassemble pursuant to section 2 of this concurrent res-
6 olution, whichever occurs first.

7 SEC. 2. The Speaker of the House and the Majority
8 Leader of the Senate, acting jointly after consultation
9 with the Minority Leader of the House and the Minority
10 Leader of the Senate, shall notify the Members of the
11 House and Senate, respectively, to reassemble whenever,
12 in their opinion, the public interest shall warrant it.
