CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of the Congress that the President
should submit a National Energy Policy Plan to Congress.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That it is the sense of the Congress that the
3 President should, no later than January 1, 1996, and bi-
4 ennially thereafter through 2006, submit a National En-
5 ergy Policy Plan to the Congress, together with proposals
6 for implementing legislation, that will provide for energy
7 self-sufficiency for the United States at the earliest prac-
8 ticable date.
