A BILL

To extend the authority of the Secretary of the Treasury to enter into agreements with certain cities and counties for the withholding of city and county income and employment taxes from the pay of Federal employees who are residents of, or regularly employed in, such cities and counties.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That (a) paragraph (1) of section 5520(c) of title 5,
4 United States Code, is amended—
5 (1) by striking the comma at the end of sub-
6 paragraph (B)(iii) and inserting a period; and

1 (2) by striking “within the political boundaries
2 of which 500 or more persons are regularly em-
3 ployed by all agencies of the Federal Government;”.

4 (b) Paragraph (2) of such section is amended by
5 striking “Census and within the political boundaries of
6 which 500 or more persons are regularly employed by all
7 agencies of the Federal Government;” and inserting
8 “Census.”.
