Mr. GEKAS (for himself and Mr. ROYCE) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Government Reform and Oversight

A BILL

To prohibit the use of credit cards by officers and employees of the Federal Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON USING CREDIT CARDS.**

4 (a) PROHIBITION.—An officer or employee of a Fed-
5 eral agency may not use for any purpose a credit card
6 issued to such agency (or to such officer or employee in
7 his or her official capacity).

8 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

9 (1) The term “credit card” means any card,
10 plate, coupon book, or other credit device existing

1 for the purpose of obtaining money, property, labor,
2 or services on credit.

3 (2) The term “Federal agency” means any de-
4 partment, agency, or instrumentality of the execu-
5 tive, legislative, or judicial branch of the Federal
6 Government.

7 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act shall take effect on
8 the date of the enactment of this Act.
