2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON AUTHORITY TO LICENSE NU-**

4 **CLEAR WASTE STORAGE FACILITIES.**

5 Title I of the Nuclear Waste Policy Act of 1982 (42
6 U.S.C. 10121 et seq.) is amended by inserting after sec-
7 tion 101 the following:

1 **“SEC. 102. LIMITATION ON AUTHORITY TO LICENSE, CON-**

2 **STRUCT, OR OPERATE NUCLEAR WASTE**

3 **STORAGE FACILITIES.**

4 “The Commission shall not have authority, under this

5 Act or any other law, to issue a license for, and it shall

6 be unlawful for any person to construct or operate, a facil-

7 ity or repository for interim or permanent storage of low-

8 level radioactive waste, high-level radioactive waste, or

9 spent nuclear fuel at a place outside 1 of the 50 States

10 or the District of Columbia.”.
