6 **INDIVIDUALS.**

1 484(j)(3)(B)) is amended by inserting after “homeless in-
2 dividuals” the following: “, providers of assistance to fami-
3 lies or individuals whose annual incomes are below the
4 poverty line (as that term is defined in section 673 of the
5 Community Services Block Grant Act),”.
