1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMERICAN FOLKLIFE CENTER.**

4 Section 8 of the American Folklife Preservation Act
5 (20 U.S.C. 2107) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “1994, and” and inserting
7 “1994,”; and

8 (2) by inserting “, \$1,187,000 for the fiscal
9 year ending September 30, 1996, \$1,187,000 for the
10 fiscal year ending September 30, 1997, \$1,187,000

1 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 1998, and
2 \$1,187,000 for the fiscal year ending September 30,
3 1999" after "1995".
