## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to make reimbursement of defense contractors for costs of excessive amounts of compensation for contractor personnel unallowable under Department of Defense contracts.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXCESSIVE COMPENSA-**

4                   **TION OF DEFENSE CONTRACTOR PERSONNEL**

5                   **PROHIBITED.**

6       Section 2324(e)(1) of title 10, United States Code,

7       is amended by adding at the end the following:

1           “(P) Costs of compensation (including bonuses  
2        and other incentives) paid with respect to the serv-  
3        ices (including termination of services) of any one  
4        individual to the extent that the total amount of the  
5        compensation paid in a fiscal year exceeds  
6        \$250,000.”.
