3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF WINFIELD SCOTT STRATTON**

5 The United States Post Office building located at 201
6 East Pikes Peak Avenue, Colorado Springs, Colorado,
7 shall be known and designated as the “Winfield Scott
8 Stratton Post Office”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the building
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the “Winfield Scott Stratton Post Office”.
