To provide for State regulation of prices charged for services provided by, and routes of service of, motor vehicles that provide tow or wrecker services, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FOR THE TRANSPORTATION OF**
4 **TOW AND WRECKER SERVICES.**

5 Section 11501(h)(2) of title 49, United States Code,
6 is amended—

7 (1) by striking “and” at the end of subpara-
8 graph (A);

1 (2) by striking the period at the end of sub-
2 paragraph (B) and inserting a semicolon; and

3 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
4 paragraph:

5 “(C) does not apply to the provision of tow
6 or wrecker services by a motor vehicle.”.
