Mr. LUGAR introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Agriculture, Nutrition, and Forestry

A BILL

To provide authority for the assessment of cane sugar produced in the Everglades Agricultural Area of Florida, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EVERGLADES AGRICULTURAL AREA.**

4 Section 206 of the Agricultural Act of 1949 (7 U.S.C.
5 1446g) is amended—

6 (a) in subsection (i)—

7 (1) in paragraph (1)—

8 (A) by redesignating subparagraph

9 (B) as (C);

1 (B) in subparagraph (A) by striking
2 “and” after the semicolon; and

3 (C) by inserting “and” after the semi-
4 colon in subparagraph (B); and

5 (D) by inserting a new subparagraph
6 (C) that reads as follows:

7 “(C) in the case of marketings from pro-
8 duction from the Everglades Agricultural Area
9 of Florida as determined by the Secretary, in
10 addition to assessments under subparagraph B,
11 the sum of 2 cents per pound of raw cane sugar
12 for each of the 1996 through 2000 fiscal
13 years;”

14 (b) by redesignating subsection (j) as subsection
15 (k); and

16 (c) by inserting a new subsection (j) that reads
17 as follows:

18 " (j) EVERGLADES AGRICULTURAL AREA Ac-
19 COUNT.—

20 “(1) IN GENERAL.—

21 “(A) ACCOUNT.—The Secretary shall es-
22 tablish an Everglades Agricultural Area Ac-
23 count as an account of the Commodity Credit
24 Corporation.”

1 “(B) AREA.—The Secretary shall determine the extent of the Everglades Agricultural
2 Area of Florida for the purposes of subsection
3 (i)(1)(C) and subparagraph (C).

5 “(C) COMMODITY CREDIT CORPORATION.—The funds collected from the assessment provided in subsection (i)(1)(C) shall be paid into the Everglades Agricultural Area Account of the Commodity Credit Corporation, and shall be available until expended.

11 “(D) PURPOSES.—The Secretary is authorized and directed to transfer funds from the Everglades Agricultural Area Account to the South Florida Water Management District or other appropriate public entities for the purpose of purchasing agricultural lands in the Everglades Agricultural Area of Florida and for other related purposes.”.
