3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States courthouse located at 800 Market
5 Street in Knoxville, Tennessee, shall be known and des-
6 ignated as the “Howard H. Baker, Jr. United States
7 Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
4 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
5 to be a reference to the “Howard H. Baker, Jr. United
6 States Courthouse”.
