Mr. PRESSLER (for himself and Mr. DASCHLE) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize a land conveyance at the Radar Bomb Scoring Site, Belle Fourche, South Dakota.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, RADAR BOMB SCORING**

4 **SITE, BELLE FOURCHE, SOUTH DAKOTA.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Secretary of
6 the Air Force may convey, without consideration, to the
7 Belle Fourche School District, Belle Fourche, South Da-
8 kota (in this section referred to as the “District”), all
9 right, title, and interest of the United States in and to
10 a parcel of real property, together with any improvements

1 thereon, consisting of approximately 37 acres located in
2 Belle Fourche, South Dakota, which has served as the lo-
3 cation of a support complex and housing facilities for De-
4 tachment 21 of the 554th Range Squadron, an Air Force
5 Radar Bomb Scoring Site located in Belle Fourche, South
6 Dakota. The conveyance may not include any portion of
7 the radar bomb scoring site located in the State of Wyo-
8 ming.

9 (b) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE.—The conveyance
10 authorized under subsection (a) shall be subject to the
11 condition that the District—

12 (1) use the property and facilities conveyed
13 under that subsection for education, economic devel-
14 opment, and housing purposes; or

15 (2) enter into an agreement with an appro-
16 priate public or private entity to sell or lease the
17 property and facilities to such entity for such pur-
18 poses.

19 (c) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
20 and legal description of the property conveyed under this
21 section shall be determined by a survey satisfactory to the
22 Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be borne by the
23 District.

24 (d) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The
25 Secretary may require such additional terms and condi-

1 tions in connection with the conveyance under this section
2 as the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter-
3 ests of the United States.
