## A BILL

To amend the Communications Act of 1934 to repeal the amendments relating to obscene and harassing use of telecommunications facilities made by the Communications Decency Act of 1995.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF AMENDMENTS.**

4       Effective on the day after the date of the enactment  
5 of the Communications Decency Act of 1995, the amend-  
6 ments made to section 223 of the Communications Act  
7 of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 223) by section 502 of the Commu-  
8 nications Decency Act of 1995 are repealed and the provi-

1 sions of such section 223 as in effect on the day before  
2 such date shall have force and effect.
