3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF AMENDMENTS.**

4 Effective on the day after the date of the enactment
5 of the Communications Decency Act of 1995, the amend-
6 ments made to section 223 of the Communications Act
7 of 1934 (47 U.S.C. 223) by section 502 of the Commu-
8 nications Decency Act of 1995 are repealed and the provi-

- 1 sions of such section 223 as in effect on the day before
- 2 such date shall have force and effect.
