A BILL

To modify the project for navigation, Mississippi River Ship Channel, Gulf to Baton Rouge, Louisiana, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MISSISSIPPI RIVER SHIP CHANNEL, GULF TO
4 BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA.**

5 The project for navigation, Mississippi River Ship
6 Channel, Gulf to Baton Rouge, Louisiana, authorized by
7 the matter under the heading “CORPS OF ENGINEERS—
8 CIVIL” under the heading “DEPARTMENT OF DE-
9 FENSE—CIVIL” in chapter IV of title I of the Supple-

1 mental Appropriations Act, 1985 (99 Stat. 313), is modi-
2 fied to require the Secretary of the Army, as part of the
3 operations and maintenance segment of the project, to as-
4 sume responsibility for periodic maintenance dredging of
5 the Chalmette Slip to a depth of minus 33 feet mean low
6 gulf.
