## A BILL

To specify that States may waive certain requirements relating to commercial motor vehicle operators under chapter 313 of title 49, United States Code, with respect to the operators of certain farm vehicles, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVERS FOR CERTAIN FARM VEHICLES.**

4       (a) DEFINITIONS.—As used in this section:

5           (1) CUSTOM HARVESTING FARM MACHINERY.—

6       The term “custom harvesting farm machinery” in-  
7       cludes vehicles used for custom harvesting that—

6 (B) are used on a seasonal basis to provide  
7 transportation of—

10 (ii) harvesting machinery and equip-  
11 ment from farm to farm.

12 (2) COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE.—The  
13 term “commercial driver's license” has the meaning  
14 provided that term in section 31301(3) of title 49,  
15 United States Code.

16 (b) WAIVERS.—In addition to the authority granted  
17 to States to waive the application of chapter 313 of title  
18 49, United States Code, with respect to farm vehicles de-  
19 scribed in 53 Fed. Reg. 37313–37316 and farm-related  
20 service industries described in 57 Fed. Reg. 13650–13654,  
21 each State that issues commercial driver’s licenses in ac-  
22 cordance with chapter 313 of title 49, United States Code,  
23 may waive the application of any requirement for obtain-  
24 ing a commercial driver’s license for operators of custom

- 1 harvesting farm machinery or employees of farm-related
- 2 service industries (or both) that would otherwise apply.
