A BILL

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.**

4 The United States Courthouse at 235 North Wash-
5 ington Avenue in Scranton, Pennsylvania, shall be known
6 and designated as the “William J. Nealon United States
7 Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the Federal
4 building referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be
5 a reference to the “William J. Nealon United States
6 Courthouse”.
