2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIMINATION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN SEMI-MAN-
4 UFACTURED FORMS OF GOLD.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheading 7108.13.50 of the
6 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended to read as follows:

“	7108.13.50	Other	Free	Free (CA, E, IL, J, MX)	65%	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
