## A BILL

To prohibit the purchase of foreign beef by a school participating in the school lunch, school breakfast, or child care food program, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. AMERICAN BEEF IN CHILD NUTRITION PRO-**  
4       **GRAMS.**

5       The National School Lunch Act (42 U.S.C. 1751 et  
6       seq.) is amended by adding at the end the following:

1 **“SEC. 28. AMERICAN BEEF IN CHILD NUTRITION PRO-**  
2 **GRAMS.**

3 “A school or service institution in the continental  
4 United States participating in the school lunch program,  
5 the school breakfast program under section 4 of the Child  
6 Nutrition Act of 1966 (42 U.S.C. 1773), or the child care  
7 food program under section 17 may not purchase beef or  
8 beef food-products produced outside the United States for  
9 use in carrying out the program.”.
