3 **SECTION 1. MEDICAL FOODS.**

4 Section 8904(a) of title 5, United States Code, is

6 (1) in paragraph (1)(E) by striking the period
7 at the end and inserting “, including with respect to

1 medical foods (as defined by section 5(b)(3) of the
2 Orphan Drug Act (21 U.S.C. 360ee(b)(3))).”; and
3 (2) in paragraph (2)(F) by striking the period
4 at the end and inserting “, including medical foods
5 (as defined by section 5(b)(3) of the Orphan Drug
6 Act (21 U.S.C. 360ee(b)(3))).”.

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
