A BILL

To extend the authority for the Homeless Veterans' Reintegration Projects for fiscal years 1997 through 1999, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF AUTHORITY.**

4 (a) HOMELESS VETERANS' REINTEGRATION
5 PROJECTS.—Section 738(e)(1) of the Stewart B. McKin-
6 ney Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11448(e)(1)) is
7 amended by adding at the end the following:

8 “(E) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1997.

9 “(F) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1998.

10 “(G) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 1999.”.

1 (b) GENERAL AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIA-
2 TIONS.—Section 739(a) of such Act (42 U.S.C. 11449(a))
3 is amended by striking out “the fiscal years 1994 and
4 1995” and inserting in lieu thereof “fiscal years 1994
5 through 1999”.

6 (c) EXTENSION OF PROGRAM.—Section 741 of such
7 Act (42 U.S.C. 11450) is amended by striking out “De-
8 cember 31, 1997” and inserting in lieu thereof “Septem-
9 ber 30, 1999”.

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
