A BILL

To protect the first amendment rights of employees of the Federal Government.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of
4 law, no employee of the Federal Government shall be pe-
5 remptorily removed without public hearings from his or
6 her position because of remarks made during personal
7 time in opposition to the Federal Government's policies,
8 or proposed policies regarding homosexuals, and any such

- 1 individual so removed prior to date of enactment of this
- 2 Act shall be reinstated to his or her previous position.
