A BILL

For the relief of Joe W. Floyd.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY FOR RETIRED PAY.**

4 (a) **ELIGIBILITY.**—Notwithstanding any other provi-
5 sion of law, Joe W. Floyd of Holcomb, Mississippi, shall
6 be deemed to have performed 20 years of qualifying serv-
7 ice for purposes of determining his eligibility for retired
8 pay under sections 12731 and 12732 of title 10, United
9 States Code.

10 (b) **REQUIREMENT FOR APPLICATION.**—The individ-
11 ual referred to in subsection (a) shall, after the date of
12 the enactment of this Act, submit an application in the

1 form and manner provided for payment of retired pay
2 under section 12732 of title 10, United States Code.

3 (c) PROSPECTIVE APPLICABILITY.—Retired pay shall
4 be paid under section 12731 of title 10, United States
5 Code, to the individual referred to in subsection (a) only
6 for months beginning after the date on which the applica-
7 tion for the retired pay is submitted in accordance with
8 subsection (b).
