A BILL

To repeal the increase in tax on social security benefits.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF TAX INCREASE ON SOCIAL SECU-**
4 **RITY BENEFITS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 13215 of the Revenue
6 Reconciliation Act of 1993 is hereby repealed, and the In-
7 ternal Revenue Code of 1986 shall be applied and adminis-
8 tered as if such section (and the amendments made there-
9 by) had not been enacted.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
3 December 31, 1993.
