A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to require the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to furnish outpatient medical services for any disability of a former prisoner of war.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ELIGIBILITY OF FORMER PRISONERS OF WAR**
4 **TO RECEIVE OUTPATIENT MEDICAL SERV-**
5 **ICES FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS**
6 **AFFAIRS.**

7 Section 1712(a)(1) of title 38, United States Code,
8 is amended—

1 (1) by striking out “and” at the end of sub-
2 paragraph (C);

3 (2) by striking out the period at the end of sub-
4 paragraph (D) and inserting in lieu thereof “; and”;
5 and

6 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
7 paragraph:

8 “(E) to any former prisoner of war for any
9 disability.”.

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
