A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide that the reduction by waiver of retired pay due to receipt of compensation or pension not apply to retired pay attributable to pay for extraordinary heroism.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXCLUSION OF PAY FOR EXTRAORDINARY HER-**
4 **OISM FROM REQUIRED REDUCTION IN RE-**
5 **TIRED PAY AS PART OF RECEIPT OF COM-**
6 **PENSATION OR PENSION.**

7 (a) EXCLUSION.—The first sentence of section 5305
8 of title 38, United States Code, is amended by inserting

1 “(other than pay for extraordinary heroism payable to the
2 person under section 1402(f), 1402a(f), 3991(a)(2),
3 6330(c)(3), or 8991(a)(2) of title 10)” after “such per-
4 son’s retired or retirement pay”.

5 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
6 subsection (a) shall take effect on the date of the enact-
7 ment of this Act. No person shall be entitled to receive
8 by reason of the amendment made by subsection (a) any
9 benefits for any period before such date.
