## A BILL

To require a General Accounting Office study of duplication among certain international affairs grantees.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. GENERAL ACCOUNTING OFFICE STUDY OF**  
4                       **DUPLICATION AMONG CERTAIN INTER-**  
5                       **NATIONAL AFFAIRS GRANTEES.**

6       (a) STUDY OF CERTAIN GRANTEES FOR DUPLICA-  
7       TION OF FUNCTIONS.—The Comptroller General of the  
8       United States shall conduct a study on the purposes and  
9       activities of the North/South Center, East-West Center,  
10      Asia Foundation, and the National Endowment for De-

1 mocracy on the extent to which the activities of these orga-  
2 nizations duplicate activities that are conducted elsewhere  
3 in the United States Government. Such study shall in-  
4 clude, but not be limited to, an evaluation of whether such  
5 organizations undertake unique activities that are central  
6 to the conduct of American foreign policy and which are  
7 incapable of being performed directly by an agency of the  
8 United States Government.

9 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than one year  
10 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller  
11 General of the United States shall prepare and submit a  
12 report of the findings of such study to the Committee on  
13 Foreign Relations of the Senate and Committee on Inter-  
14 national Relations of the House of Representatives.
