RESOLUTION

To express the sense of the Senate that Congress should vote on the deployment of United States Armed Forces in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

1 *Resolved*, That it is the sense of the Senate that Congress should vote on a measure regarding deployment of U.S. Armed Forces in the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina as part of the Implementation Force of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, prior to the United States entering into a commitment to carry out such deployment.
