## A BILL

To amend the Agricultural Market Transition Act to authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to extend the term of marketing assistance loans.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF MARKETING ASSISTANCE**  
4 **LOANS.**

5 Section 133 of the Agricultural Market Transition  
6 Act (7 U.S.C. 7233) is amended by striking subsection  
7 (c) and inserting the following:

8 “(c) EXTENSION.—The Secretary may extend the  
9 term of a marketing assistance loan made to producers

1 on a farm for any loan commodity for one 6-month pe-  
 2 riod.”.
