A BILL

To increase funding for child care under the temporary assistance for needy families program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. INCREASED FUNDING FOR CHILD CARE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 418(a) of the Social Secu-
5 rity Act (42 U.S.C. 618(a)) is amended by striking para-
6 graph (3) and inserting the following:

7 “(3) APPROPRIATION.—For grants under this
8 section, there are appropriated—

9 “(A) \$2,967,000,000 for fiscal year 1997;

10 “(B) \$3,067,000,000 for fiscal year 1998;

1 “(C) \$3,167,000,000 for fiscal year 1999;

2 “(D) \$3,367,000,000 for fiscal year 2000;

3 “(E) \$3,567,000,000 for fiscal year 2001;

4 and

5 “(F) \$3,717,000,000 for fiscal year

6 2002.”.

7 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
8 subsection (a) shall take effect as if enacted on August
9 22, 1996.
