Mr. LEVIN (for himself and Mr. JEFFORDS) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing use of the Capitol Grounds for “America Recycles Day” national kick-off campaign.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR AMERICA RE-**
4 **CYCLES DAY NATIONAL KICK-OFF CAMPAIGN.**

5 The “America Recycles Day” campaign and its
6 agents may sponsor a public event on the Capitol Grounds
7 on September 30, 1997, or on such date as the Speaker
8 of the House of Representatives and the President pro
9 tempore of the Senate may jointly designate.

1 SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The event authorized under section 1 shall be free to the public and arranged so as not to interfere with the needs of Congress, under conditions to be prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police.

7 (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—“America Recycles Day” and its agents shall assume full responsibility for all expenses and liabilities incident to all activities associated with the event.

11 SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.

12 (a) STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT.—Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Capitol, “America Recycles Day” and its agents are authorized to erect on the Capitol Grounds any stage, tent, sound amplification devices, and other related structures and equipment required for the event authorized under section 1.

18 (b) ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.—The Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police Board are authorized to make any other reasonable arrangements as may be required to plan for or administer the event.
