Mr. LEVIN (for himself and Mr. JEFFORDS) submitted the following concurrent resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Governmental Affairs

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing use of the Capitol Grounds for “America Recycles Day” national kick-off campaign.

1 *Resolved by the Senate (the House of Representatives*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR AMERICA RE-**
4 **CYCLES DAY NATIONAL KICK-OFF CAMPAIGN.**

5 The “America Recycles Day” campaign and its
6 agents may sponsor a public event on the Capitol Grounds
7 on September 30, 1997, or on such date as the Speaker
8 of the House of Representatives and the President pro
9 tempore of the Senate may jointly designate.

1 **SEC. 2. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The event authorized under sec-
 3 tion 1 shall be free to the public and arranged so as not
 4 to interfere with the needs of Congress, under conditions
 5 to be prescribed by the Architect of the Capitol and the
 6 Capitol Police.

7 (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—“America Recy-
 8 cles Day” and its agents shall assume full responsibility
 9 for all expenses and liabilities incident to all activities as-
 10 sociated with the event.

11 **SEC. 3. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

12 (a) STRUCTURES AND EQUIPMENT.—Subject to the
 13 approval of the Architect of the Capitol, “America Recy-
 14 cles Day” and its agents are authorized to erect on the
 15 Capitol Grounds any stage, tent, sound amplification de-
 16 vices, and other related structures and equipment required
 17 for the event authorized under section 1.

18 (b) ADDITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS.—The Architect of
 19 the Capitol and the Capitol Police Board are authorized
 20 to make any other reasonable arrangements as may be re-
 21 quired to plan for or administer the event.
