## A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of West Virginia.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF DEADLINE AND REINSTATE-  
4       MENT OF LICENSE.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period  
6       specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16  
7       U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-  
8       ergy Regulatory Commission project numbered 7307, the  
9       Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the  
10      project, in accordance with the good faith, due diligence,

1 and public interest requirements of that section and the  
2 Commission's procedures under that section, extend the  
3 time period during which the licensee is required to com-  
4 mence construction of the project until September 26,  
5 2003.

6 (b) APPLICABILITY.—Subsection (a) shall take effect  
7 on the expiration of the period required for commencement  
8 of construction of the project described in subsection (a).

9 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If the  
10 license for the project described in subsection (a) has ex-  
11 pired prior to the date of enactment of this Act, the Com-  
12 mission shall reinstate the license effective as of the date  
13 of its expiration and extend the time required for com-  
14 mence ment of construction of the project until September  
15 26, 2003.
