RESOLUTION

Congratulating Nancy Johnson on winning the first gold
medal of the 2000 Olympic games in Sydney, Australia.

Whereas Nancy Johnson, a native of Downers Grove, Illinois,
captured the first gold medal of the 2000 summer Olympic
games in Sydney, Australia, by winning the women's
10 meter air rifle competition;

Whereas Nancy Johnson's victory was the culmination of
years of hard work, dedication, and participation in international
competition, including the 1996 Olympic games in Atlanta, the 1999 Pan American Games, and the 1998
World Championships;

Whereas Nancy Johnson's Olympic performance and shooting
achievements have raised the level of awareness and appreciation
for women's sports throughout the United States and the world;

Whereas Nancy Johnson's gold-medal-winning performance epitomizes the goals and ideals of the Olympics, which include a commitment to excellence, grace under pressure, and good will toward fellow competitors; and

Whereas Nancy Johnson has honored the Nation through her dedication to excellence and high achievement: Now, therefore, be it

8 United States Olympic effort and to the advancement
9 of women's sports.
