## A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend expensing of environmental remediation costs for an additional 6 years and to include sites in metropolitan statistical areas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF EXPENSING OF ENVIRON-**  
4 **MENTAL REMEDIATION COSTS.**

5 (a) EXPANSION OF TARGETED AREAS.—Subpara-  
6 graph (A) of section 198(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue  
7 Code of 1986 (defining targeted area) is amended by re-  
8 designating clauses (i) through (iv) as clauses (ii) through

1 (v), respectively, and by inserting before clause (ii) (as so  
2 redesignated) the following new clause:

3 “(i) any metropolitan statistical area  
4 (within the meaning of section  
5 143(k)(2)(B)),”.

6 (b) EXTENSION.—Section 198(h) of the Internal  
7 Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to termination) is amend-  
8 ed by striking “2001” and inserting “2007”.

9 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
10 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after  
11 December 31, 2000.
