# A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on n-Heptanoic acid.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. N-HEPTANOIC ACID.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7       new heading:

“	9902.29.03	n-Heptanoic acid (CAS No. 111- 14-8) (provided for in subheading 2915.90.18) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2002	”.

8       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
9       subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or

- 1 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
- 2 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
