A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ADJUSTMENT OF COMPOSITE THEORETICAL**
4 **PERFORMANCE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1211(d) of the National
6 Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 1998 (50
7 U.S.C. App. 2404 note) is amended—

8 (1) in the second sentence, by striking “180”
9 and inserting “30”; and

1 (2) by adding at the end, the following new sen-
2 tence: “The 30-day reporting requirement shall
3 apply to any changes to the composite theoretical
4 performance level for purposes of subsection (a) pro-
5 posed by the President on or after January 1,
6 2000.”.
