## A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to provide for duty-free treatment on certain manufacturing equipment.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN MANUFAC-**  
4       **TURING EQUIPMENT.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subheadings 9902.84.79,  
6       9902.84.83, 9902.84.85, 9902.84.87, 9902.84.89, and  
7       9902.84.91 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the  
8       United States are each amended—

9               (1) by striking “4011.91.50” each place it ap-  
10       pears and inserting “4011.91”;

1           (2) by striking “4011.99.40” each place it ap-  
2           pears and inserting “4011.99”; and

3           (3) by striking “86 cm” each place it appears  
4           and inserting “63.5 cm”.

5           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
6           subsection (a) apply with respect to goods entered, or  
7           withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
8           the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of  
9           this Act.
