A BILL

To designate the facility of the United States Postal Service located at 114 Ridge Street in Lenoir, North Carolina, as the “James T. Broyhill Post Office Building”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. JAMES T. BROYHILL POST OFFICE BUILDING.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 114 Ridge Street in Lenoir,
6 North Carolina, shall be known and designated as the
7 “James T. Broyhill Post Office Building”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.— Any reference in a law, map,
9 regulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “James T. Broyhill
3 Post Office Building”.
