## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain machines designed for children’s education.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CERTAIN CHILDREN’S EDUCATIONAL DEVICES.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.85.43	Electrical machines and apparatus principally designed for the education of children (provided for in subheading 8543.90.88) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2002	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn  
3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day  
4 after the date of enactment of this Act.
