3 **SECTION 1. MANDATORY SEPARATION AGE FOR FIRE-**
4 **FIGHTERS.**

5 (a) CIVIL SERVICE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—

6 (1) IN GENERAL.—The second sentence of sec-
7 tion 8335(b) of title 5, United States Code, is
8 amended—

1 (A) by inserting “, firefighter,” after “law
2 enforcement officer”; and

3 (B) by inserting “, firefighter,” after “that
4 officer”.

5 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
6 8335(b) of title 5, United States Code, is amended
7 by striking the first sentence.

8 (b) FEDERAL EMPLOYEES’ RETIREMENT SYSTEM.—

9 (1) IN GENERAL.—The second sentence of sec-
10 tion 8425(b) of title 5, United States Code, is
11 amended—

12 (A) by inserting “, firefighter,” after “law
13 enforcement officer”; and

14 (B) by inserting “, firefighter,” after “that
15 officer”.

16 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section
17 8425(b) of title 5, United States Code, is amended
18 by striking the first sentence.
