Mr. MURKOWSKI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Finance

A BILL

To amend section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to exempt State and local political committees from required notification of section 527 status.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF STATE AND LOCAL POLITICAL
4 COMMITTEES FROM CERTAIN REPORTING
5 REQUIREMENTS.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 527(i)(5) of the Internal
7 Revenue Code of 1986 (as added by section 1 of Public
8 Law 106-230) is amended by striking “or” at the end
9 of subparagraph (A), by striking the period at the end

1 of subparagraph (B) and inserting “, or”, and by adding

2 at the end the following:

3 “(C) any State or local committee of a po-
4 litical party or political committee of a State or
5 local candidate.”.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
7 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in section
8 1 of Public Law 106–230.
