Mr. HARKIN introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred  
to the Committee on Finance

## A BILL

To establish a Chief Labor Negotiator in the Office of the  
United States Trade Representative.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       (a) ESTABLISHMENT OF POSITION.—There shall be  
4       in the Office of the United States Trade Representative  
5       a Chief Labor Negotiator. The Chief Labor Negotiator  
6       shall be appointed by the President, with the rank of Am-  
7       bassador, by and with the advice and consent of the Sen-  
8       ate.

9       (b) FUNCTIONS.—The Chief Labor Negotiator shall  
10      have as his or her primary function the conduct of trade

1 negotiations relating to labor-related issues and shall have  
2 such other functions as the United States Trade Rep-  
3 resentative may direct.

4 (c) COMPENSATION.—The Chief Labor Negotiator  
5 shall be paid at the highest rate of basic pay payable to  
6 a member of the Senior Executive Service.
