3 SECTION 1. DESIGNATION.

4 The facility of the United States Postal Service lo-
5 cated at 203 West Paige Street in Tompkinsville, Ken-
6 tucky, shall be known and designated as the “Tim Lee
7 Carter Post Office Building”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the facility
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the Tim Lee Carter Post Office Building.
