A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to provide that witnesses at Federal grand jury proceedings have the right to the assistance of counsel.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 That chapter 215 of title 18, United States Code, is

4 amended—

5 (1) by adding at the end the following:

6 **“§ 3323. Right to assistance of counsel**

7 “A witness before a grand jury shall have the right

8 to have an attorney present in the room where the grand

9 jury is sitting to assist that witness while the witness is

10 being questioned.”; and

1 (2) by adding at the end of the table of sections
2 at the beginning of such chapter the following new
3 item:

“3323. Right to assistance of counsel.”.
