## A BILL

To repeal the wool and mohair subsidy provided in the Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies Appropriations Act, 2001.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF WOOL AND MOHAIR SUBSIDY.**

4       (a) REPEAL.—Section 814 of the Agriculture, Rural  
5 Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Re-  
6 lated Agencies Appropriations Act, 2001 (as enacted by  
7 Public Law 106-387; 114 Stat. 1549A-55), is repealed.

8       (b) EFFECT OF REPEAL.—The repeal of such section  
9 814 by subsection (a) shall not alter the validity of any

1 payments made on or before the date of the enactment  
2 of this Act to producers of wool or producers of mohair  
3 for the 2000 marketing year under such section.
