# A BILL

To extend the deadline under part I of the Federal Power Act for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Nevada.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY  
4 REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period  
6 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16  
7 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to Federal Energy  
8 Regulatory Commission project numbered 10756, the  
9 Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the  
10 project and after reasonable notice, in accordance with the

1 good faith, due diligence, and public interest requirements  
2 of that section and the Commission's procedures under  
3 that section, extend the time period during which the li-  
4 censee is required to commence the construction of the  
5 project for 3 consecutive 2-year periods.

6 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—Subsection (a) shall take ef-  
7 feet on the expiration of the extension issued by the Com-  
8 mission for Federal Energy Regulatory Commission  
9 project numbered 10756.

10 (c) REINSTATEMENT OF EXPIRED LICENSE.—If the  
11 period required for commencement of construction of the  
12 project described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the  
13 date of the enactment of this Act, the Commission shall  
14 reinstate the license effective as of the date of its expira-  
15 tion and the first extension authorized under subsection  
16 (a) shall take effect on the date of such expiration.
