A BILL

To provide funds for the planning of a special census of Americans residing abroad.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FINDINGS; SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

4 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that—

5 (1) an estimated 3,000,000 to 6,000,000 Americans live and work overseas while continuing to vote
6 and pay taxes in the United States;

18 (b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Con-
19 gress that—

20 (1) the Bureau of the Census should carry out
21 a special census of all Americans residing abroad in
22 2004;

1 cans residing abroad may be included in the 2010
2 decennial census;

12 SEC. 2. FUNDING TO BEGIN PLANNING FOR A SPECIAL CEN-
13 SUS OF AMERICANS RESIDING ABROAD.

14 For necessary expenses in connection with the plan-
15 ning of a special census of Americans residing abroad (as
16 described in section 1(b)(1)), there is appropriated, out-
17 of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated,
18 \$5,000,000 for fiscal year 2002, to remain available until
19 expended.
